Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Pembroke Wines and Spirits 2025 Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **24 Dungarvon Street, Wānaka**, and known as "**Pembroke Wines & Spirits Wanaka**" to any person for consumption off the premises, and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 11.00pm

- c) Drinking water must be freely available at all times alcohol is being sold and supplied.
- d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions of the supply of alcohol to minors and the prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons, identification of minors.
- e) The entire premises is designated as **supervised** at all times, in accordance with the plans submitted to the District Licensing Committee on 10 March 2025.
- f) According to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 the premises is assigned the fees category: **Medium Tavern (Off)**.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- a) Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.
